

Big Forest Fire in Massachusetts.

SANDWICH, Mass., April 15.—A forest fire started in Cataumet this morning. It has raged all day over a tract of land between that place and Sandwich fifteen miles long and from one to four miles wide, and is not under control. It has destroyed some of the most valuable wood land in this vicinity. The loss cannot be estimated. Over 100 workmen from Sandwich are fighting the fire, but they have made little headway. The fire has reached Great Hollow Hill. It is moving in a northeasterly direction, and is within about two miles of the town. Back fires are built all along the main thoroughfares between Cataumet and Cautuit, and it is hoped the efforts of the fighters will soon be rewarded.
